This summer has been a scorcher with many counties currently in a heat advisory. Knowing the signs of heat-related illnesses such as heat stroke and heat exhaustion can save a life.

**Weeds Down River** – A trip past Duke’s Bridge, through the Control Device (Stop Logs) around the “horseshoe” area, which is fairly clear of weeds, due to the last spraying, and you will come to the “transition” area. With the low water levels and the amount of sunlight we have been receiving, this area is full of weeds. The recommendation was made, and your West Lakes Association approved Aquatic Weed Control to spray this area in the next few weeks – approx. 6 acres at \$400 per acre – not to exceed \$2400.00. This should be a good “kill” and will help the waterflow for the remainder of this year, and even into next Spring. As with anything around our lakes, the weather plays a huge role...we just have to wait and see what the rain we recently received does to this plan.
