The Five Lakes Conservation Association (Indian Lakes chain) had their August Board meeting last week. The Board approved a \$1,000 donation to West Lakes Association to go towards the cost of weed treatment that was done on 6/28/19. Based on the Aquatic Weed Control follow up report, it was very successful and no doubt helped with the drainage issue.

The Five Lakes Board recognizes the effort your Association is putting forward on addressing the slow drainage problem and realizes this helps the entire St. Joseph River watershed and specifically the North Branch of the Little Elkhart River that runs through both West Lakes and Indian Lakes.

I suggested to the Five Lakes Board that we may want to consider getting together with West Lakes Board similar to my visit with you several weeks ago to learn more of the studies and other related activities West Lakes are pursuing. Any opportunity for West Lakes and the Indian Lakes to partner on water quality and quantity issues should prove to be beneficial. Maybe a meeting this fall?

I assume we make the check out to West Lakes Association and mail to your address? I'll need your address if that's the case.

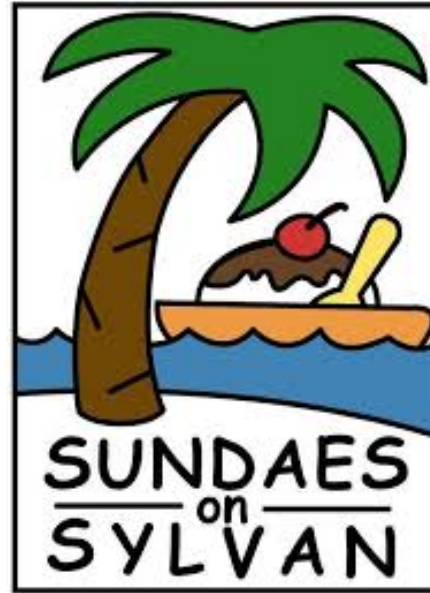
